Notes about application for Volunteer Scheme for Probationers

The Volunteer Scheme for Probationers (VSP) aims at promoting greater community involvement in the rehabilitation of offenders. Under this Scheme, selected volunteers are guided by Probation Officers to help probationers develop meaningful hobbies and cultivate healthy pursuits. Volunteers can also assist in providing guidance and advice on school work, job hunting, child care and management of household chores etc., as well as organizing activities for probationers.

Under this Scheme, volunteers will not take over the role of Probation Officers who are taking up statutory duties and solving the behavioural problems of probationers.

Applicants should be aged 21 or over with mature personality, and must have completed Form Five (F. 5) or above.
